



Required Infant Supplies

- Diapers/Cloth Diapers
 - When child is using cloth diapers please provide a small garbage can that teachers may dispose soiled diapers for your family to take home each night.
- Wipes
- Bottles
 - Please bring in a bottle for each feeding time (average of 3-6 bottles per day)
 - Bottles need to be placed in a gallon size bag with child's name labeled on each bottle.
- Formula/Breast Milk
 - Sweet Beginnings is participating in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) allowing us to provided formula for our infant families. If you choose to have Sweet Beginnings provide formula for your infant, we use the brand Simply Right Complete.
 - When providing your own brand of formula, please label with your child's name.
 - If you are using breast milk, please make sure you bring in enough for each feeding and have extra on hand. All breast milk needs to be labeled with child's name.
- Bedding- Cot sheet and blanket/swaddle
 - To help your infant feel the most comfortable, please provide bedding that is similar to what you use at home. A standard crib sheet fits our cribs and cots.
- Extra Clothing
 - Please bring in 3 complete changes of clothes.

Recommended Infant Supplies

- Extra Cot Sheet, Blanket, and Swaddle
- Diaper Cream
- Nasal Aspirator
- Gas Drops

All personal items must be clearly labeled with your child's name.



Required Toddler/Preschool/Pre-Kindergarten Supplies

- Milk Cup/Water Cup
 - If your child is assigned to a toddler classroom, please bring in two sippy cups. One for water and one for milk. They will stay at school and be washed daily.
- Water Bottles
 - If your child is in one of our preschool classrooms, please bring in a water bottle for them to use throughout the day. Water bottles will stay at school and be washed daily.
- Extra Clothes
 - As the seasons change, make sure to replace your child's extra clothes for weather and size appropriate clothing.
- Cot sheet and blanket for rest time. A standard crib sheet works best.
- Sunscreen
 - During the summer months we will apply sunscreen for afternoon recess. Your child should arrive to school daily with sunscreen already applied.
- Diapers/Cloth Diapers/Pull-ups
 - If your child is using cloth diapers, please provide a small garbage can that staff can dispose soiled diapers for your family to take home each night.

Potty Training Supplies

- Extra Clothes
 - 5 extra pants
 - 5 extra underwear
 - Socks
 - Shoes
- Extra cot sheet and blanket
